THE RHBT WILL BE AT CRE SOUTH-WEST AT EXETER



It has been a game-changer'.



Everything in the capital, Addis Ababa, right has slowed down. Printers are laying off workers, and are facing a serious lack of printing paper'.

NEPAL - pray for the distribution of 'When I Saw Him' and 'We would See Jesus' in the Nepali language.
