JEAN HALL DAVEY: 9 August 1935 - 1 June 2021

Norma Jean Hall was born and grew up in Turner, Kansas, USA. Her loving family fostered Christian values, even though her parents were not Christians during her childhood.

In 1958, after university and a year teaching, Jean began studies at *Moody Bible Institute*. Jean then went to Mexico in 1958, 1959, and 1960.

In December 1960, Betty Snavely and she sailed to Spain, joining George and Drena Verwer and Mike and Diane McKinley on the first OM team in Madrid.

In the summer of 1963, nearly two thousand joined the outreach. Jean led a women's team to three of the most fanatically Catholic provinces of northern Spain,

then under the Franco dictatorship. Police arrested them thirteen times and finally deported them. Undeterred, Jean and a colleague drove along to the next border post and re-entered Spain to continue. Jean loved the adventure of it all!

Later that year, while working in Bolton, England, as George Verwer's secretary, she and Gerry Davey were granted 'social permission', eventually marrying in Kansas, USA in December 1964.

In 1967, Bromley, England became home. Over the next eighteen years, Gerry developed and directed *Send the Light*, the English-language Christian literature branch of OM. Gerry was later seconded from OM to be General Secretary of the *East European Literature Advisory Committee*.

The Daveys mentored local colleagues across the region, helping them establish indigenous Christian publishing houses in ten countries. While Jean's official role was providing administrative support, her real joy, as she accompanied Gerry on numerous trips, was in building friendships, fellowship and trust with many people in these fascinating countries.

In her own view, her most important ministry was to: 'Support my husband and raise my children God gave us, guiding them to love and follow Jesus and to work as a team'.

Jean never drew attention to herself, and humbly walked through her seventy years of Christian ministry with an attitude of service.
