

ETHIOPIA

Roy Hession: 'Calvary Road' and 'We would See Jesus' in the Amharic language.

Ethiopia's recent conflict in the northern Tigray region, along with the rise of the virus in the country, plus a disruption of paper supplies to all printing companies, has inevitably slowed down the production process for this project. Do please pray for our brother Tesfaye who, on our behalf, oversees the printing and publishing in Addis Ababa - thank you.

FRANCE

<u>Roy Hession</u>: 'Good News for Bad People' in the **French** language.

BLF Editions is a publishing house based in the north of France. They publish Christian books for Frenchlanguage readers, incl. 'My Calvary Road' in past years.

NEPAL

Roy Hession: 'When I Saw Him' and 'We would See Jesus' in the **Nepali** language.

The translator says, 'I am your fellow-Christian working in His vineyard of Nepal. One of my burdens has been translating deeper English Christian books into the Nepali language, and I have been doing that for the last 20 years. I have translated many titles into Nepali. I have been tremendously blessed and edified reading Roy Hession's books and have undertaken to translate "We would see Jesus" and "When I saw Him". I studied English literature in the States and stayed there for eight years. I am fluent both in English and Nepali'.

In January, the editor says, 'However, 'Calvary Road' is not yet printed. Because the files we had were quite old. I sent it for another edit after the new layout. The final edit was done and last night, actually, I got an email from the layout person with a question about a line division. That should be settled today and they will send the print PDFs before the end of next week'.

VIETNAM

Roy Hession: 'Calvary Road' in the **Vietnamese** language.
